DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S MOTION TO STAY

The Division of Enforcement ("Division") moves to stay this Proceeding against Respondent Mark Allan Plummer ("Plummer" or "Respondent") and respectfully states as follows:

- The Commission has ordered the Division to submit, no later than October 3, 2025,
 additional evidentiary materials relevant to its motion for default judgment against Respondent.
- 2. Due to a lapse in appropriations, the SEC shut down as of October 1, 2025. Most personnel have been furloughed (with limited exceptions) and are prohibited from working. The Division attorneys assigned to this matter are being furloughed and thus are not available to work on this matter.
- 3. Employees are not permitted to work on a voluntary basis when furloughed. *See* 31 U.S.C. § 1342.
- 4. Accordingly, it is appropriate that all activity in this administrative proceeding be stayed until the shutdown ends.

For the reasons described above, the Division respectfully requests that the Commission stay this proceeding until the shutdown ends. The Division further requests leave to submit
