Subsequently, an Order for Additional Briefing was issued on September 30, 2024. Counsel for Mr. Robertson received notification of the order on October 2nd, 2024. 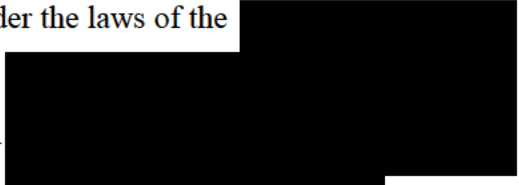
