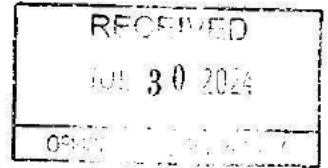

Please be advised, on Securities Capital Corporation's behalf, I, Juanita S. Jones, Co-Owner, am seeking to appeal the recent ruling issued by FINRA pertaining to the firm's membership status. We are reaching out to the Securities and Exchange Commission asking for an extension to bring current, all delinquent filings leading to Securities Capital Corporation's recent FINRA membership expulsion on June 21, 2024.

We find ourselves at this junction due to the unforeseen and untimely death of Michael A. Jones, Co-Owner and Founder of Securities Capital Corporation. During his tenure as the CEO/Chief Compliance Officer and General Securities Principal, he maintained timely focus report filings and oversaw yearly annual audits.

We are asking for this extension to gain access to password protected information on Michael's computer that is relevant to complete delinquent focus report filing submissions as well as information for the 2023 annual audit.

We are also asking for additional time to contact our customers as it pertains to Michael's passing and Securities Capital Corporation's FINRA membership status. Securities Capital Corporation is also seeking permission to answer any questions customers may have concerning their accounts and their account handling going forward.
