DECLARATION OF SANDHYA C. HARRIS
TO ASSIST SECRETARY WITH RECORD OF SERVICE

SANDHYA C. HARRIS, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, declares:

1. I am a Senior Counsel with the Division of Enforcement (“Division”) of the Securities and Exchange Commission, and co-counsel for the Division in the captioned administrative proceeding. I am submitting this Declaration to assist the Secretary in maintaining a record of service on the respondent in the captioned proceeding pursuant to Rule 141(a)(3).

2. The Office of the Secretary provided me with the U.S. Certified Mail tracking number for the copy of the Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”) mailed by the Secretary to the respondent in this proceeding. I input the tracking number into the Hong Kong Post package tracking system on its Internet website located at https://webapp.hongkongpost.hk/en/mail_tracking/index.html, and printed out the tracking confirmation in order to obtain confirmation of the delivery or attempted delivery of the OIP on the respondent. A true copy of the tracking confirmation for the respondent is attached as

Exhibit 1, hereto. Rule 141(a)(2)(ii) provides that service on a corporation or entity may be obtained by confirmation of attempted delivery on the most recent address shown on the entity's most recent filing with the Commission.

3. In order to determine whether mail service was an acceptable means of service in Hong Kong, which is now a special administrative region of the People's Republic of China, I checked the website of the Hague Conference on Private International Law, and determined that both Hong Kong and the United States are signatories to the Hague Convention. The People's Republic of China provides a different set of Hague Convention declarations pertaining to Hong Kong than it does for mainland China. Specifically, the People's Republic of China does not provide Article 10(a) declaration pertaining to Hong Kong, thus Hong Kong does not have a 109a) declaration pertaining to Hong Kong, thus Hong Kong does not have a 10(a) objection to postal channels. *See Ackermann V. Levine*, 788 F.2c 830, 839 (2d Cir. 1986). *See also*, <https://www.hcch.net/index.cfm?oldlang=en&act=authorities.details&aid=393>

4. The Secretary mailed the OIP to respondent SHARING ECONOMY INTERNATIONAL INC., CIK 819926 ("SEII"), via Certified Mail, Tracking No. RF 592 997 098 US, to the address shown on its most recent EDGAR filing at No.85 Castle Peak Road Castle Peak Bay Tuen Mun, N.T., Hong Kong. This address is taken from SEII's last filing with the Commission, which was a Form 10-K filed with the Commission on April 20, 2023. The USPS tracking system confirms that it was delivered on November 8, 2024. *See Exhibit 1 at page 2.*

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.

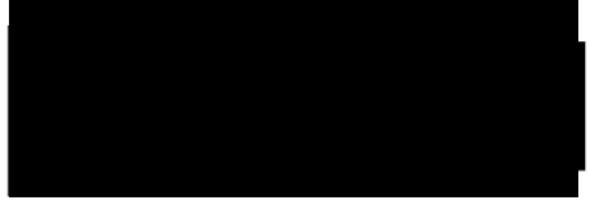
