**NOTICE OF THE DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S INTENT TO FILE ITS

On February 13, 2025, the Commission ordered the Division of Enforcement ("Division") to file any reply to its pending motion for summary disposition by March 21, 2025. *See* Exch. Act Rel. In view of the potential shutdown of the federal government at the end of the day on March 14, 2025, the Division hereby states its intent to file its reply seven calendar days after the end of the federal government shutdown should such shutdown occur. Furthermore, in the event of a federal government shutdown, the Division respectfully requests that this notice be considered a motion for an extension of time to file its reply brief under Commission Rule of

Practice 161. In the event there is no federal government shutdown, the Division will file its reply on the existing due date of March 21, 2025.
