Pursuant to Rule 322 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, the Division of Enforcement ("Division"), with the consent of Respondent Epic Capital Wealth Advisors, LLC, through its principal David Anthony, files this Unopposed Motion for a Protective Order:

The parties anticipate that documents relevant to this proceeding, including documents to be made available to Respondent for inspection and copying pursuant to Rule 230 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, will contain confidential information. Such confidential information may include bank records or brokerage-account information, sensitive customer, financial, or business information, or other personally identifiable information ("PII") protected by the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552a.

To protect the confidentiality of such information, and to govern the production, discovery, and dissemination thereof, the Division, with Respondent's consent, respectfully requests that the Protective Order submitted herewith be entered in this matter. The parties agree that a Protective Order is necessary because the harm resulting from disclosure of such confidential information would outweigh the benefits of disclosure. The parties further agree that they will abide by the terms of the Protective Order while this motion is pending, which will

allow for the timely production of potentially confidential information even before the Protective Order is formally entered.
