On February 24, 2025, in response to a letter from Respondent sent to the Division, the Commission extended Respondent’s time to answer the OIP. He did not answer. Accordingly, on May 7, 2025, the Commission ordered Respondent to show cause by June 23, 2025, why he should not be deemed to be in default. The Commission also ordered the Division to file a motion for default by July 21, 2025, should Respondent not answer the OIP. The Division complied with that Order.
