Rouse*, 2005 SEC LEXIS 2488, Securities Act Rel. 8622; Exchange Act Rel. 52551, Administrative Proceeding File No. 3-11346 (Oct. 3, 2005) (the "Commission Order") (Exhibit A hereto).
- 3) The Commission now seeks an order requiring Defendant to comply with the Commission Order pursuant to Section 20(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 ("Securities Act") and Section 21(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ("Exchange Act") [15 U.S.C. § 78u(e)].
