ORDER GRANTING CROSS-PETITION FOR REVIEW AND EXTENDING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

On December 17, 2013, we issued an order granting Toby G. Scammell's petition for review of the administrative law judge's initial decision,<sup>1</sup> pursuant to Commission Rule of Practice 411,<sup>2</sup> and ordering that a brief in support of the petition for review be filed by January 16, 2014,<sup>3</sup> a brief in opposition be filed by February 15, 2014, and any reply brief be filed by March 1, 2014. But, due to an oversight, the December 17, 2013 order overlooked the fact that the Division of Enforcement had filed a cross-petition for review regarding certain evidentiary issues. Accordingly, pursuant to Rule of Practice 411, we hereby grant the Division's cross-petition for review. We also extend the time periods within which the brief in opposition and reply brief must be filed in order to give the parties an opportunity to address the matters raised in the Division of Enforcement's cross-petition for review.
