Wedbush Securities, Inc. and Edward William Wedbush, filed an application, pursuant to Section 19(d)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934,<sup>1</sup> for review of disciplinary action taken against them by the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority ("FINRA"). FINRA filed a copy of the index to the record on January 26, 2015, pursuant to Rule 420(d) of the Rules of Practice.<sup>2</sup>

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 450(a) of the Rules of Practice,<sup>3</sup> that a brief in support of the application for review shall be filed by March 26, 2015. A brief in

opposition shall be filed by April 27, 2015, and any reply brief shall be filed by May 11, 2015.<sup>4</sup> Pursuant to Rule 180(c) of the Rules of Practice,<sup>5</sup> failure to file a brief in support of the application may result in dismissal of this review proceeding.
