SCHEDULING
BRIEFS

Constantine Gus Cristo filed an application for review of action taken by the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (“FINRA”). On June 26, 2018, FINRA informed the Commission that it was unable to file a copy of the index to the record in this proceeding. At this time, the parties should submit briefs limited to the issue of whether the Commission has jurisdiction over this appeal pursuant to Section 19(d)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.¹

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 450(a) of the Rules of Practice,² that the applicant file a brief addressing the issue of the Commission’s jurisdiction by August 17, 2018. FINRA shall file a response brief addressing that issue by September 17, 2018, and the applicant shall file any reply brief by October 1, 2018.³ Pursuant to Rule 180(c) of the Rules of Practice, failure to file a brief may result in dismissal of this review proceeding.⁴
