ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

On May 14, 2018, FINRA's National Adjudicatory Council issued an order denying Windsor Street Capital's membership continuance application and terminating its FINRA membership because the firm had not met its burden of demonstrating that its continued membership in FINRA was in the public interest. Windsor Street filed an application for review of FINRA's decision with the Commission on May 17, 2018. On June 20, 2018, the order scheduling briefs in this appeal was issued.

On June 22, 2018, Windsor Street filed a withdrawal of its application for review. In that document, Windsor Street represented that it has ceased its broker-dealer business. Given these circumstances, it is appropriate to grant Windsor Street's request to withdraw its application for review.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the request of Windsor Street Capital, L.P. to withdraw its application for review is granted and that this review proceeding is dismissed.
