**ORDER VACATING MUNICIPAL SECURITIES DEALER, MUNICIPAL ADVISOR,
TRANSFER AGENT, AND NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED STATISTICAL RATING
ORGANIZATION BARS**

Edward L. Maggiacomo, Jr. seeks to vacate an order, dated October 15, 2014 (the “Order”), to the extent that it bars him from association with a municipal securities dealer, municipal advisor, transfer agent, or nationally recognized statistical rating organization, subject to a right to reapply after five years.¹ The bars at issue were imposed based solely on conduct occurring prior to July 22, 2010, the effective date of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.² Accordingly, in our discretion, we vacate the Order to the extent it prohibits Edward L. Maggiacomo, Jr. from associating with a municipal securities dealer, municipal advisor, transfer agent, or nationally recognized statistical rating organization, subject to a right to reapply after five years, but otherwise leave the Order unmodified.
