BRIEFS

Kurt Charles Jackson filed an application for review of action taken by the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (“FINRA”). FINRA filed a copy of the index to the record on December 20, 2018, pursuant to Rule 420(e) of the Rules of Practice.¹ At this time, the parties should submit briefs limited to the issue of whether the Commission has jurisdiction over this appeal pursuant to Section 19(d)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.²

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 450(a) of the Rules of Practice,³ that the applicant file a brief addressing the issue of the Commission’s jurisdiction by March 1, 2019. FINRA shall file a response brief addressing that issue by April 1, 2019, and the applicant

shall file any reply brief by April 15, 2019.⁴ Pursuant to Rule 180(c) of the Rules of Practice, failure to file a brief may result in dismissal of this review proceeding.⁵
