ORDER REGARDING STATUS OF MATTER

On November 19, 2018, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Respondent Robert William Myers, Jr.<sup>1</sup> Myers, acting pro se, filed his answer on December 17, 2018. On April 9, 2019, the parties submitted a joint “Notice of Discussions” stating that they had “engaged in initial discussions about the possibility of settling this matter” and that they “should be able to report in the next ten days whether they will be able to reach an agreement.”

It appears that there have been no filings in this matter since the “Notice of Discussions” submitted on April 9. Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the parties file a statement advising the Commission of the status of this matter by June 19, 2019. If the parties are still in the process of conferring, they may apprise the Commission of that fact.
