ORDER SCHEDULING BRIEFS

J.W. Korth & Company filed an application, pursuant to Section 19(d)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934,<sup>1</sup> for review of disciplinary action taken against it by the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority ("FINRA"). FINRA filed a copy of the index to the record on July 2, 2019, pursuant to Rule 420(e) of the Rules of Practice.<sup>2</sup>

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 450(a) of the Rules of Practice,<sup>3</sup> that a brief in support of the application for review shall be filed by August 22, 2019. A brief in

opposition shall be filed by September 23, 2019, and any reply brief shall be filed by October 7, 2019.<sup>4</sup> Pursuant to Rule 180(c) of the Rules of Practice, failure to file a brief in support of the application may result in dismissal of this review proceeding.<sup>5</sup>
