## ORDER

On September 21, 2020, the Commission issued an order instituting administrative proceedings ("OIP"), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, against Integral Technologies, Inc. ("Respondent"). Respondent filed an answer on September 28, 2020. The OIP contemplated that the parties would subsequently hold a prehearing conference and file a report identifying any agreements reached at it.<sup>2</sup>

On November 23, 2020, the Division of Enforcement filed a motion requesting to adjourn the prehearing conference "with the consent of the Respondent." The motion represented that the parties have "engaged in settlement discussions" and "anticipate that this matter will settle" but "need additional time to conclude settlement discussions and prepare the related settlement paperwork."

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the Division's motion is GRANTED, that the prehearing conference and the hearing are continued indefinitely, and that the parties file a status report concerning settlement efforts by December 23, 2020, and every 28 days thereafter.
