ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

On March 4, 2019, Timothy Arthur Vanderver III filed with the Commission an application for review of FINRA action. Vanderver had submitted a claim for arbitration with FINRA's Office of Dispute Resolution requesting expungement of certain customer dispute information. FINRA notified Vanderver that his claim was not eligible for arbitration, and he appealed.

On January 5, 2021, Vanderver filed an unopposed motion to withdraw his application for review. Under the circumstances, it is appropriate to grant Vanderver's unopposed request.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the request of Timothy Arthur Vanderver III to withdraw his application for review is granted and that this review proceeding is dismissed.
