ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

On February 28, 2019, Donald Anthony Wojnowski filed with the Commission an application for review of FINRA action. Wojnowski had submitted a claim for arbitration with FINRA's Office of Dispute Resolution requesting expungement of certain customer dispute information. FINRA notified Wojnowski that his claim was not eligible for arbitration, and he appealed.

On May 18, 2021, Wojnowski filed an unopposed motion to withdraw his application for review. Under the circumstances, it is appropriate to grant Wojnowski's unopposed request.¹

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the request of Donald Anthony Wojnowski to withdraw his application for review is granted and that this review proceeding is dismissed.
