ORDER REGARDING SERVICE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”) on May 27, 2021, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, against respondent International Technology Enterprises Ltd. (“Respondent”).<sup>1</sup> It appears that there have been no other filings in this proceeding since issuance of the OIP, including as to whether the OIP was served on the respondent, which the OIP states is located in Belize.<sup>2</sup> To assist the Office of the Secretary in maintaining a record of service that establishes that the OIP has been properly served,<sup>3</sup> it is ORDERED that the Division of Enforcement file a status report concerning service of the OIP by September 8, 2021, and every 28 days thereafter until service is accomplished.

The parties’ attention is directed to the most recent amendments to the Commission’s Rules of Practice, which took effect on April 12, 2021, and which include new e-filing requirements.<sup>4</sup>
