ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

On September 21, 2021, Michael Allen Neuenschwander filed with the Commission an application for review of FINRA action. Neuenschwander had submitted a claim for arbitration with FINRA Dispute Resolution Services requesting expungement of certain information from the Central Registration Depository. FINRA notified Neuenschwander that his claim was not eligible for arbitration, and he appealed.

On October 28, 2021, Neuenschwander filed an unopposed motion to withdraw his application for review. Under the circumstances, it is appropriate to grant Neuenschwander's unopposed request.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the request of Michael Allen Neuenschwander to withdraw his application for review is granted and that this review proceeding is dismissed.
