EXTENSION ORDER

The Division of Enforcement has requested an extension of time of seven days, or until March 18, 2022, to file evidentiary materials and a supporting brief relevant to its motion for default and imposition of sanctions, as requested in a previous order in this proceeding.<sup>1</sup> It appears appropriate to grant the Division of Enforcement's request for good cause shown.

It is ORDERED that the time for the Division of Enforcement to file evidentiary materials and a supporting brief relevant to its motion for default and imposition of sanctions is extended until March 18, 2022.

It is further ORDERED that Tucker may file a brief by April 18, 2022, addressing the same matters to be addressed by the Division, consistent with the parameters explained in our February 9, 2022 order.
