ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO FILE ADDITIONAL BRIEFS

On January 25, 2021, the Commission granted the petition of Respondent Laurie Bebo for review of an administrative law judge's initial decision.¹ On June 14, 2022, Respondent sought leave to file a supplemental brief regarding the Fifth Circuit's recently decided decision in *Jarkesy v.
