ORDER REGARDING SERVICE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”) on August 18, 2022, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, against respondent Lescarden Inc. (“Respondent”).¹

On September 16, 2022, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration stating that the OIP was served on Respondent by sending it via Priority Mail Express to the address on Respondent’s most recent filing with the Commission, a Form 12b-25 filed on August 29, 2017. However, that Form 12b-25 lists Respondent’s suite number as Suite 300, whereas the Division’s declaration lists the suite number as Suite 212. Therefore, it appears that the record does not establish that service of the OIP has been accomplished.

To assist the Office of the Secretary in maintaining a record of service that establishes that the OIP has been properly served,² IT IS ORDERED that the Division of Enforcement file a status report concerning service of the OIP by October 26, 2022, and every 28 days thereafter until service is accomplished.
