ORDER REGARDING SERVICE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”), on September 7, 2022, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, against Energem Resources, Inc. f/k/a DiamondWorks Ltd. (“Respondent”).<sup>1</sup>

On September 21, 2022, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration stating that the OIP was served on Respondent by sending it via Priority Mail Express to the address in Canada on Respondent’s most recent filing with the Commission, which the declaration states was a Form 20-F filed on May 27, 1999. But EDGAR reflects that Respondent filed a Form 6-K on November 14, 2002, which provides two addresses different than that stated in the Form 20-F referenced by the Division: an address in South Africa listed as Respondent’s principal executive offices, and another address in Canada. The main page on EDGAR for Respondent also identifies the South Africa address as Respondent’s business and mailing address. Therefore, it appears that the record does not establish that service of the OIP has been accomplished.

To assist the Office of the Secretary in maintaining a record of service that establishes that the OIP has been properly served,<sup>2</sup> IT IS ORDERED that the Division of Enforcement file a status report concerning service of the OIP by November 14, 2022, and every 28 days thereafter until service is accomplished.
