ORDER REGARDING SERVICE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”) on September 15, 2022, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, against Van Nuys Studios, Inc. (“Respondent”).¹

On September 22, 2022, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration stating that the OIP was served on Respondent by sending it by Priority Mail Express to the address on Respondent’s most recent filing with the Commission, which the declaration states was a Form 8-A12G filed on February 14, 2003. But EDGAR reflects that the Form 8-A12G provided a different address than the address noted in the Division’s declaration.² Therefore, it appears that the record does not establish that service of the OIP has been accomplished.

To assist the Office of the Secretary in maintaining a record of service that establishes that the OIP has been properly served,³ IT IS ORDERED that the Division of Enforcement file a status report concerning service of the OIP by December 2, 2022, and every 28 days thereafter until service is accomplished.
