ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

On October 20, 2021, Alice Jean Solomon, formerly an associated person of a FINRA member firm, filed an application for review of a FINRA action. Solomon had filed a claim in FINRA's arbitration forum seeking to expunge from her Central Registration Depository record information about a prior arbitration award entered against her. FINRA notified Solomon that her claims were inappropriate for arbitration, and she appealed.

On May 3, 2023, Solomon filed an unopposed motion to withdraw her application for review. Under the circumstances, it is appropriate to grant Solomon's unopposed request.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the request of Alice Jean Solomon to withdraw her application for review is granted and that this review proceeding is dismissed.
