ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE REPLY

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting administrative proceedings on November 2, 2022, against Daliang “David” Guo pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.¹ The parties filed a joint prehearing conference statement on April 18, 2023, and the Division filed a motion for summary disposition the following day. On April 24, 2023, we issued a scheduling order directing Guo to file any opposition to the Division’s motion by June 5, 2023, and directing the Division to file any reply by July 10, 2023.²

On June 1, 2023, the Commission’s Office of the Secretary received a submission from Guo entitled “Prehearing Respondent” and bearing the case number of the civil action in which a federal district court permanently enjoined Guo from certain provisions of the federal securities laws.³ The submission did not attach a certificate of service or otherwise indicate that Guo served it on the Division.

We construe Guo’s June 1, 2023, submission to be his opposition to the Division’s motion for summary disposition. We again remind Guo that in the future, he must serve the

Division with a copy of any document that he files with the Commission,⁴ and he must include a certificate of service with each document that he files.⁵

Under the circumstances, it is appropriate to grant the Division additional time to file its reply. Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the Division's reply is due by July 17, 2023.
