EXTENSION ORDER

The Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (“FINRA”) has requested that the deadline for filing FINRA’s brief in opposition to the application for review be extended to October 4, 2023, and that the deadline for filing Joseph Sylvester Sturniolo’s (“Applicant’s”) reply brief be extended to October 18, 2023. FINRA represents that Applicant does not oppose FINRA’s request. It appears appropriate to grant FINRA’s request for good cause shown.¹

It is therefore ORDERED pursuant to Rule 161 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice that the time for FINRA to file a brief in opposition is extended to October 4, 2023, and the time for Applicant to file a reply brief is extended to October 18, 2023.
