ORDER REGARDING SERVICE

On September 21, 2023, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings ("OIP") against THE DOCS, INC. ("Respondent") pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.¹ It appears that there have been no filings in this proceeding with respect to whether the OIP was served upon Respondent. To assist the Office of the Secretary in maintaining a record of service that establishes that the OIP has been properly served,² IT IS ORDERED that the Division of Enforcement file a status report concerning service of the OIP by November 13, 2023, and every 28 days thereafter until service is accomplished.
