ORDER SCHEDULING BRIEFS

On October 31, 2023, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (“OIP”) against Eric Christopher Cannon (“Respondent”) pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.¹ On April 29, 2024, the Division of Enforcement filed a motion for summary disposition. On May 1, 2024, Respondent filed a renewed motion for an order staying or dismissing this proceeding.

We believe it is appropriate to set a briefing schedule for these motions to facilitate their orderly resolution.² Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent’s opposition brief to the Division’s summary disposition motion shall be filed by May 24, 2024, and any reply brief may be filed by June 3, 2024. Likewise, the Division’s opposition brief to the Respondent’s stay motion shall be filed by May 24, 2024, and any reply brief may be filed by June 3, 2024. This
