ORDER DISMISSING PROCEEDING

On September 15, 2022, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting administrative proceedings against Robert Lenard Booth a/k/a Trevor Nicholas pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to determine what, if any, remedial action was appropriate in the public interest against Booth following his conviction in federal district court.¹ On September 20, 2024, the Division of Enforcement filed a motion to dismiss the proceeding, stating that Booth had died on September 10, 2024, and thus there was no purpose or public interest in continuing the proceeding. Under the circumstances, it is appropriate to grant the Division's request.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that this proceeding is dismissed.
