ORDER REGARDING SERVICE

On September 4, 2024, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (“OIP”) against Nanomix Corp. (“Respondent”) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.¹

On October 2, 2024, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration stating that the OIP was served on Respondent by sending it via U.S. Certified Mail to the address on Respondent’s most recent filing with the Commission, a Form 8-K filed on November 24, 2023. However, the tracking number listed in the declaration does not match the number of the tracking information attached to the declaration. Therefore, it appears that the record does not establish that service of the OIP has been accomplished in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii).²

To assist the Office of the Secretary in maintaining a record of service that establishes that the OIP has been properly served,³ IT IS ORDERED that the Division of Enforcement file a status report concerning service of the OIP by November 8, 2024, and every 28 days thereafter until service is accomplished.
