ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

In February 2025, Ronald Moschetta filed an application for review of FINRA action. FINRA filed a motion to dismiss, and Moschetta filed an opposition to that motion. On May 1, 2025, FINRA filed a corrected request for a six-day extension to file its reply.¹ Under the circumstances, it appears appropriate to grant FINRA's request for good cause shown.²

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that FINRA shall file its reply to Moschetta's opposition by May 5, 2025.
