Certain Administrative Proceedings

ORDER

On February 2, 2026, due to a lapse in appropriations, the Commission stayed certain administrative proceedings.¹ Appropriations to the Commission have now been restored. Accordingly, the Commission hereby lifts the stay.

The Commission was subject to a lapse in appropriations from January 31, 2026, to February 3, 2026, for a total of four days. The February 2, 2026 order provided that the stay applied to any period of time prescribed in or allowed by the Commission's Rules of Practice or any order issued by the Commission or a hearing officer. We now order that any period, deadline, or other date subject to the February 2, 2026 order is further extended by an additional 10 days. This extension thus adds a ten-day extension to the stay order's existing effect on deadlines.
