It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of Continan Communications, Inc. Therefore, it is ordered, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, that trading in the securities of Continan is suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EDT on April 1, 2009, through 11:59 p.m. EDT on April 15, 2009.
