It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of Corix Bioscience, Inc. (“CXBS”) (CIK No. 0001433821) because of questions regarding the accuracy of assertions by CXBS, a Wyoming corporation whose principal place of business is listed as Surprise, Arizona, and by others, in current Internet postings available to investors concerning, among other things, the company’s assets and operations in Nevada. This information includes claims that CXBS holds a valid, state-issued export license in Nevada for growing, processing, and distributing industrial hemp. The company’s common stock is quoted on OTC Link, operated by OTC Markets Group Inc., under the ticker symbol CXBS.

The Commission is of the opinion that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of the above-listed company.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, that trading in the securities of the above-listed company is suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EDT on April 13, 2018 through 11:59 p.m. EDT on April 26, 2018.
