**ORDER OF SUSPENSION  
OF TRADING**

It is the opinion of the Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of BlackPoll Fleet International, Inc. (“BlackPoll”), because of concerns of potentially manipulative trading in Blackpoll’s common stock. BlackPoll (CIK No. 1562201) is a Nevada corporation with principal offices in Sunrise, Florida. Its stock is quoted on OTC Link (previously, “Pink Sheets”), operated by OTC Markets Group, Inc., under the ticker symbol BPOL.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, that trading in the securities of the above-listed company is suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EDT on April 30, 2018, through 11:59 p.m. EDT on May 11, 2018.
