**ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF
TRADING**

It appears to the Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of Eco-Shift Power Corp. (“ECOP”) (CIK No. 885475), a void Delaware corporation located in Cambridge, Ontario, Canada with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g) because it is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports since it filed a Form 10-Q for the period ended March 31, 2015. On April 30, 2019, Corporation Finance sent a delinquency letter to ECOP requesting compliance with its periodic filing requirements, but ECOP did not receive the delinquency letter due to its failure to maintain a valid address on file with the Commission as required by Commission rules (Rule 301 of Regulation S-T, 17 C.F.R. Section 232.301 and Section 5.4 of EDGAR Filer Manual). As of August 16, 2019, the common stock of ECOP was quoted on OTC Link, had seven market makers, and was eligible for the “piggyback” exception of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

The Commission is of the opinion that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of the above-listed company. Therefore, it is ordered, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, that trading in the

securities of the above-listed company is suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EDT on September 5, 2019, through 11:59 p.m. EDT on September 18, 2019.
