[PROPOSED] ORDER APPOINTING A TAX ADMINISTRATOR, APPOINTING A DISTRIBUTION AGENT, APPROVING THE DISTRIBUTION PLAN, AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF THE TAX OBLIGATIONS OF THE DISTRIBUTION FUND AND THE RELATED FEES AND EXPENSES OF THE TAX ADMINISTRATOR WITHOUT FURTHER COURT ORDER

The Court, having reviewed Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's ("Commission" or the "SEC") Motion and accompanying Memorandum of Law in Support thereof for an Order: (1) appointing Miller Kaplan Arase LLP ("Miller Kaplan") as Tax Administrator; (2) appointing Sondra Panahi, a Commission employee, as Distribution Agent; (3) approving the proposed Distribution Plan; and (4) authorizing the SEC to approve and arrange for the payment of the tax obligations of the Distribution Fund and related fees and expenses of the Tax Administrator from the Distribution Fund without further Court order (the "Motion") and for good

cause shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED**;

2. Miller Kaplan is appointed Tax Administrator to execute all income tax reporting

requirements, including the preparation and filing of tax returns, for all funds under the Court's

jurisdiction in this case (the "Distribution Fund");

3. The Tax Administrator shall be entitled to charge reasonable fees for tax

compliance services and related expenses in accordance with its agreement with the SEC for the

Tax Year 2025. The Tax Administrator shall, at such times as the Tax Administrator deems

appropriate, submit a request to the SEC's counsel of record for payment of its fees and expenses

from the Distribution Fund;

4. Sondra Panahi, a Commission employee and Trial Counsel for the Commission, is

hereby appointed Distribution Agent (the "Distribution Agent") for the Distribution Fund that is

under this Court's jurisdiction;

5. The Distribution Plan is approved; and

6. The Commission staff is authorized to approve and direct the payment of the

Distribution Fund's tax obligations, and the fees and expenses of the Tax Administrator without

further order of the Court. All payments for taxes and the fees and expenses of the Tax

Administrator shall be reported to the Court in a final accounting.
