**CONSENT JUDGMENT AS TO  
DEFENDANT BREHNEN KNIGHT**

Pursuant to the Court’s November 18, 2024 order granting Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”)’s motion for the entry of a consent judgment as to Defendant Brehnen Knight, (Doc. No. 229), the Court enters the following consent judgment against Defendant Knight:

1 The Securities and Exchange Commission having filed a Complaint and Defendant  
2 Brehnen Knight having entered a general appearance; consented to the Court’s jurisdiction  
3 over Defendant and the subject matter of this action; consented to entry of this Judgment;  
4 waived findings of fact and conclusions of law; and waived any right to appeal from this  
5 Judgment:

6 I.

7 It Is Hereby Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that Defendant Knight is permanently  
8 restrained and enjoined from violating, directly or indirectly, Section 10(b) of the Securities  
9 Exchange Act of 1934 (the “Exchange Act”), 15 U.S.C. § 78j(b), and Rules 10b-5(a) and  
10 (c) promulgated thereunder, 17 C.F.R. § 240.10b-5(a) & (c), by using any means or  
11 instrumentality of interstate commerce, or of the mails, or of any facility of any national  
12 securities exchange, in connection with the purchase or sale of any security:

- 13 (a) to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud; or  
14 (b) to engage in any act, practice, or course of business which operates or would  
15 operate as a fraud or deceit upon any person.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, Adjudged, And Decreed that, as provided in Federal  
17 Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d)(2), the foregoing paragraph also binds the following who  
18 receive actual notice of this Judgment by personal service or otherwise: (a) Defendant  
19 Knight’s officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys; and (b) other persons in  
20 active concert or participation with Defendant Knight or with anyone described in (a).

21 II.

22 It is hereby Further Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that Defendant Knight is  
23 permanently restrained and enjoined from violating Sections 17(a)(1) and (3) of the  
24 Securities Act of 1933 (the “Securities Act”), 15 U.S.C. § 77q(a)(1) & (3), in the offer or  
25 sale of any security by the use of any means or instruments of transportation or  
26 communication in interstate commerce or by use of the mails, directly or indirectly:

- 27 (a) to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud; or  
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1 (b) to engage in any transaction, practice, or course of business which operates or  
2 would operate as a fraud or deceit upon the purchaser.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, Adjudged, And Decreed that, as provided in Federal  
4 Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d)(2), the foregoing paragraph also binds the following who  
5 receive actual notice of this Judgment by personal service or otherwise: (a) Defendant  
6 Knight's officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys; and (b) other persons in  
7 active concert or participation with Defendant Knight or with anyone described in (a).

8 III.

9 It Is HEREBY Further Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that Defendant Knight is  
10 permanently restrained and enjoined from violating Sections 5(a) and (c) of the Securities  
11 Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 77e(a) & (c), by, directly or indirectly, in the absence of any applicable  
12 exemption:

- 13 (a) Unless a registration statement is in effect as to a security, making use of any  
14 means or instruments of transportation or communication in interstate  
15 commerce or of the mails to sell such security through the use or medium of  
16 any prospectus or otherwise; or  
17 (b) Unless a registration statement is in effect as to a security, carrying or causing  
18 to be carried through the mails or in interstate commerce, by any means or  
19 instruments of transportation, any such security for the purpose of sale or for  
20 delivery after sale; or  
21 (c) Making use of any means or instruments of transportation or communication  
22 in interstate commerce or of the mails to offer to sell or offer to buy through  
23 the use or medium of any prospectus or otherwise any security, unless a  
24 registration statement has been filed with the Commission as to such security,  
25 or while the registration statement is the subject of a refusal order or stop order  
26 or (prior to the effective date of the registration statement) any public  
27 proceeding or examination under Section 8 of the Securities Act, 15 U.S.C. §  
28 77h.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, Adjudged, And Decreed that, as provided in Federal  
2 Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d)(2), the foregoing paragraph also binds the following who  
3 receive actual notice of this Judgment by personal service or otherwise: (a) Defendant  
4 Knight's officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys; and (b) other persons in  
5 active concert or participation with Defendant Knight or with anyone described in (a).

6 IV.

7 IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that  
8 Defendant Knight is permanently restrained and enjoined from violating Section 9(a)(1) of  
9 the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78i(a)(1), by, directly or indirectly, by the use of the mails  
10 or any means or instrumentality of interstate commerce, or of any facility of any national  
11 securities exchange, for the purpose of creating a false or misleading appearance of active  
12 trading in any security other than a government security, or a false or misleading  
13 appearance with respect to the market for any such security, (A) to effect any transaction  
14 in such security which involves no change in the beneficial ownership thereof, or (B) to  
15 enter an order or orders for the purchase of such security with the knowledge that an order  
16 or orders of substantially the same size, at substantially the same time, and at substantially  
17 the same price, for the sale of any such security, has been or will be entered by or for the  
18 same or different parties, or (C) to enter any order or orders for the sale of any such  
19 security with the knowledge that an order or orders of substantially the same size, at  
20 substantially the same time, and at substantially the same price, for the purchase of such  
21 security, has been or will be entered by or for the same or different parties.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, Adjudged, And Decreed that, as provided in Federal  
23 Rule of Civil Procedure 65(d)(2), the foregoing paragraph also binds the following who  
24 receive actual notice of this Judgment by personal service or otherwise: (a) Defendant  
25 Knight's officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys; and (b) other persons in  
26 active concert or participation with Defendant Knight or with anyone described in (a).

V.

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2 It Is HEREBY Further Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that Defendant Knight is  
3 permanently barred from participating in an offering of penny stock, including engaging in  
4 activities with a broker, dealer, or issuer for purposes of issuing, trading, or inducing or  
5 attempting to induce the purchase or sale of any penny stock. A penny stock is any equity  
6 security that has a price of less than five dollars, except as provided in Rule 3a51-1 under  
7 the Exchange Act, 17 C.F.R. 240.3a51-1.

8 VI.

9 IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that,  
10 pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(2) and Section 20(e)  
11 of the Securities Act, 15 U.S.C. § 77t(e), Defendant Knight is prohibited from acting as an  
12 officer or director of any issuer that has a class of securities registered pursuant to Section  
13 12 of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78l, or that is required to file reports pursuant to  
14 Section 15(d) of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78o(d).

15 VII.

16 Upon motion of the Commission, the Court will determine whether it is appropriate  
17 to order disgorgement of ill-gotten gains, prejudgment interest, and/or a civil penalty  
18 pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act, 15 U.S.C. § 77t(d), and Section 21(d)(3) of  
19 the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(3), and, if so, the amount(s) of the disgorgement  
20 and/or civil penalty. In connection with the Commission's motion for disgorgement and/or  
21 civil penalties, and at any hearing held on such a motion: (a) Defendant Knight will be  
22 precluded from arguing that he did not violate the federal securities laws as alleged in the  
23 Complaint; (b) Defendant Knight may not challenge the validity of the Consent or this  
24 Judgment; (c) for the purposes of such motion, the allegations of the Complaint will be  
25 accepted as and deemed true by the Court; and (d) the Court may determine the issues  
26 raised in the motion on the basis of affidavits, declarations, excerpts of sworn deposition  
27 or investigative testimony, and documentary evidence, without regard to the standards for  
28 summary judgment contained in Rule 56(c) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. In

1 connection with the Commission’s motion for disgorgement and/or civil penalties, the  
2 parties may take discovery, including discovery from appropriate non-parties.

3 VIII.

4 It Is Further Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that the Consent is incorporated  
5 herein with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein, and that Defendant Knight  
6 must comply with all of the undertakings and agreements set forth therein.

7 IX.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, for purposes of  
9 exceptions to discharge set forth in Section 523 of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §523,  
10 the allegations in the complaint are true and admitted by Defendant Knight, and further,  
11 any debt for disgorgement, prejudgment interest, civil penalty or other amounts due by  
12 Defendant Knight under this Judgment or any other judgment, order, consent order, decree  
13 or settlement agreement entered in connection with this proceeding, is a debt for the  
14 violation by Defendant Knight of the federal securities laws or any regulation or order  
15 issued under such laws, as set forth in Section 523(a)(19) of the Bankruptcy Code, 11  
16 U.S.C. §523(a)(19).

17 X.


18 It Is Further Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that this Court will retain jurisdiction  
19 of this matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms of this Judgment.

21 There being no just reason for delay, pursuant to Rule 54(b) of the Federal Rules of  
22 Civil Procedure, the Clerk is ordered to enter this Judgment forthwith and without further
