<u>Summary of Application</u>: Applicants request an order to permit certain closed-end management investment companies that have elected to be regulated as business development companies to issue multiple classes of shares with varying sales loads and asset-based distribution and/or service fees. Applicants: PGIM Investments LLC and PGIM Private Credit Fund.

<u>Filing Dates</u>: The application was filed on November 1, 2022, and amended on May 5, 2023. <u>Hearing or Notification of Hearing</u>: An order granting the requested relief will be issued unless the Commission orders a hearing.
