<u>Summary of Application</u>: Applicants request an order to permit certain registered closed-end investment companies that have elected to be regulated as business development companies to issue multiple classes of shares with varying sales loads and asset-based distribution and/or service fees.

<u>Applicants</u>: Ares Capital Management II LLC, Ares Capital Management LLC, Ares Core Infrastructure Fund, and Ares Strategic Income Fund.

Filing Dates: The application was filed on January 8, 2025 and amended on February 28, 2025. Hearing or Notification of Hearing: An order granting the requested relief will be issued unless the Commission orders a hearing.
