<u>Summary of Application</u>: Applicants request an order to permit certain registered closed-end management investment companies and business development companies to co-invest in portfolio companies with each other and with certain affiliated investment entities.

Applicants: Tri-Continental Corporation, Columbia Credit Income Opportunities Fund, Columbia Strategic Income Private Fund, LLC, and Columbia Management Investment Advisers, LLC.

Filing Dates: The application was filed on January 7, 2025 and amended on May 6, 2025,
