Gentlemen:

This letter offers a few comments on your regulatory activities.

One of the SEC rules is that when a prospectus publishes a share owner proposal the share owner mailing address (if not printed in the prospectus) will be promptly supplied on written request. One problem is that the appropriate corporate mailing address, for sending the written request, is not given. Is it the corporate headquarters address or the address of the contractor that prints and mails the proxies or neither of the above? A request was mailed to headquarters of Conoco Phillips Corporation in April and there is still no response.

Please make a rule that when a share owner submits a proposal for voting, the share owner may additionally supply an e mail address and, if available, supply a web site address where material relating to the proposal may be viewed. The corporation uses the Internet to send the proxy and annual report to share owners. The share owners should be accorded the same rights and facility.

If we can establish such a rule for Internet communication among share owners the next step would be to organize a not for profit corporation that maintains a web site and e mail processing facility that serves all share owners for all stock corporations.
