Rule 901. Option Contracts to Be Traded

The Exchange may from time to time approve for listing and trading on the Exchange put option contracts and call option contracts in respect of underlying securities which have been selected in accordance with Rules 915 and 917. Only option contracts of a series of options approved by the Exchange and currently open for trading on the Exchange may be purchased or sold (written) on the Exchange. All such option contracts shall be designated as to the type of option, the expiration month, the expiration date, the exercise price, and the year of expiration of any option series having more than one year remaining to expiration, and shall be further designated as follows:

.01 Mini-Options Contracts. The Exchange may list mini-options contracts overlying 10 shares of SPDR S&P 500 (SPY), Apple, Inc. (AAPL), SPDR Gold Trust (GLD), Google Inc. (GOOGL), and Amazon.com Inc. (AMZN) for all expirations applicable to 100 share options on each underlying security.
