Item 2 – Educational Background and Business Experience

Sigurd Strack manages the firm's private investments business including the family of Private Opportunity Funds, all of which invest in primary and secondary investments in private equity funds and direct/co-investments in private equity and venture-backed companies on a non-discretionary basis.

Prior to joining Trinity Alps Capital, Sigurd was the Head of Private Equity and Venture investments at Willett Advisors, the investment firm managing Michael Bloomberg's personal and philanthropic assets. During his ten-year tenure, Sigurd led the portfolio build-out of leveraged buy-out, growth equity, venture capital and special situation investments. He served on more than 25 advisory boards and was the anchor and seed investor in multiple new manager formations.

Prior to his role at Willett, Sigurd served as partner and advisor at Headlands Capital and Coliseum Capital. He spent 10 years at McKinsey & Company, where he was a Partner in the firm's Global Private Equity Practice. Sigurd graduated with high distinction from the University Carolo Wilhelmina in Braunschweig (Germany) with a master's degree (Diplom) in Engineering and earned an MBA from the Haas School of Business at the University of California, Berkeley.
