Other Business Activities

Vearle is dually registered as an advisory representative of VM Jones Financial Consulting, LLC (VMJFC) and as a registered representative of Geneos Wealth Management, Inc. (Geneos), a registered broker/dealer, member of the Financial Industry Regulatory Association and SIPC. Clients are under no obligation to purchase or sell securities through Vearle. Geneos and VMJFC are not affiliated. Vearle is an independent contractor of Geneos.

Vearle may recommend you implement recommendations through Geneos. If you implement recommendations through Geneos on a non-fee basis, Vearle will receive a commission. Additionally, as further disclosed in the Disclosure Brochure under the section Brokerage Practices, Vearle may receive trail compensation for investments directed through Geneos. Therefore, there is a conflict of interest to cause a client to direct certain securities business through Geneos.

As a registered representative of Geneos, Vearle is subject to oversight by Geneos over all his securities activities and certain outside business activities. Such oversight includes review of Vearle's securities business to ensure he considers the client's best interests.

Additionally, Vearle is a licensed insurance agent. You are not obligated to purchase insurance or securities products through Vearle. However, if you implement insurance recommendations through him, he will receive commissions. The insurance business is a small minority of his business (i.e. less than 10%) and the amount of income he receives from the insurance business fluctuates depending on the amount of sales. You are advised there may be other insurance products and services available through other insurance professionals at a lower cost than those products available through Vearle.

It is important that clients refer to the disclosures under Brokerage Practices in the Disclosure Brochure.

Vearle is also actively engaged in tax and accounting services through Vearle M. Jones, CPA, which is a separate outside business for compensation. "Actively engaged" is deemed to mean the business activity represents more than 10 percent of his time and income.

Additional Compensation

Clients are advised the amount of commissions paid by Geneos to Vearle can fluctuate based on his overall production. Therefore, the more business placed by Vearle through Geneos can enable Vearle to reach another threshold enabling him to earn a higher payout. Geneos does not take into consideration the amount of business placed through Charles Schwab & Co., Inc.

Vearle does not receive any economic benefit (i.e. sales awards and other prizes) from a non-client for providing advisory services.

Supervision

Supervision and oversight of the activities conducted through VMJFC is conducted by Vearle, Managing Member and Chief Compliance Officer of VMJFC. Vearle can be contacted at 480-756-6010. Vearle reviews all account information required to establish an account as well as all transactions conducted in client's accounts. Vearle has procedures in place to be aware of any outside business activities engaged in by supervised persons of VMJFC, oversee communications with the public, and review personal trading activities of supervised persons, as well as any account over which a supervised person has direct or indirect beneficial interest.

As stated in the Disclosure Brochure and as indicated above, Geneos will also oversee the securities business of Vearle.

Because Vearle is a dually registered agent of Geneos and VMJFC, Geneos has certain supervisory and administrative duties pursuant to the requirements of Conduct Rule 3040. In that regard, Geneos will require and furnish certain account opening documentation to be completed by the client and Vearle. Once all such materials and forms have been completed by

clients in consultation with Vearle, he is required to submit these materials and forms to Geneos for its review and approval, in its capacity as Vearle's Broker/Dealer. Such review does not include the provision of investment advisory services to the VMJFC client accounts.

Requirements for State-Registered Advisers

Vearle M Jones has not been involved in any events of arbitration, civil, self-regulatory organization, administrative proceedings or bankruptcy requiring disclosure for state-registered advisers.
