Later when the stock advanced past the strike price and before the option had matured, the client complained to management that Smith Barney had misrepresented the options, and they were unsuitable. In 1999, Smith Barney paid the client \$26,250, of which Wesley contributed \$2000; however, when the options matured, the options expired worthless, and the stocks never were exercised.

Generally, Wesley does not utilize options strategies at Armada Advisors. He does hold an agent license for life insurance in the State of Florida. Insurance commissions only are a small part of his business.
