Educational Background

Mr. Ramakrishnan earned his BA in 1985, his MA in 1986 both at University of Michigan; he earned his MBA in 1988 at University of Chicago.

Business Experience

Mr. Ramakrishnan was Chief Executive Officer and Co-Chief Investment Officer at Old Lane, LP. Mr. Ramakrishnan co-founded the business in 2005 and was responsible for building out both the hedge fund and India private equity businesses both of which were launched in 2006. Mr. Ramakrishnan, a member of both the Management Committee and Investment Committee, was responsible for all the Equity and Rates strategies within the hedge fund and chaired the Investment Committee of the India Opportunities Private Equity Fund. Following the sale of Old Lane to Citigroup in 2007, Mr. Ramakrishnan sat on the Citigroup Management Committee.

Mr. Ramakrishnan's career began when he joined Morgan Stanley in the Fixed Income Division in 1988. He spent two years in the fixed income swaps and high yield securitization business. In 1990 he moved to Equity Capital markets to focus on originating derivative transactions from corporate issuers in North America. In 1992 he moved to London to work in equity derivatives and was made a Managing Director of the firm in 1995. In 1996 he was asked to assume responsibility for the equity derivatives business in Europe and to run the International Prime Brokerage and Stock Lending Businesses and later Co-headed the Global Prime Brokerage and Stock Lending Businesses. Upon his return to New York, he ran Global Equity Derivatives before he was given responsibility for Morgan Stanley's Global Equity Trading across the cash, derivatives and convertibles business. A key area of trading focus was to build out the global proprietary trading business across the qualitative and quantitative spectrum. He was responsible for pricing and risk management of all equity and convertible capital markets block trades. Guru was a member of the Institutional Securities Management Committee, the Equity Operating Committee, the firm's New Product and Capital Commitment Committee, and was President of Morgan Stanley Capital Services.
